Silver Oak and Twomey Cellars Wine Dinner at Firehouse Restaurant

SACRAMENTO, CA – The March 26 Wine Dinner at The Firehouse Restaurant in Old Sacramento will host David Duncan, president of Silver Oak and Twomey Cellars.

Raymond Twomey Duncan first came to the Napa Valley in the late 1960s, soon realizing the area's potential. Within a year, he began purchasing land throughout the Napa and Alexander Valleys. With the late Justin Meyer, Ray founded Silver Oak Cellars in 1972 with a single goal -- to create a Cabernet Sauvignon that would be deliciously drinkable upon release yet worthy of cellaring for years to come. Today, Ray and his family continue to carry that vision forward. David serves as the winery's President, overseeing production and operations. Together, brother Tim and David strive to sustain the tradition of excellence established by Silver Oak's founders.

The March 26 Wine Dinner will feature a full selection of Silver Oak-Twomey Cellars offerings, each expertly matched with the seven courses served at the Friday night Wine Dinner. The complete menu and pairings are attached.

The Wine Dinner begins at 6:30 p.m. and is limited to 24 guests. The cost for each guest is \$175 and reservations are required.

The Firehouse is named in Zagat "America's Top Restaurants 2009" and is a recipient of the 2009 Fodor's Choice distinction, included among the highest 15 percent of all restaurants listed in the international guide as recommended destinations for travelers. Additionally, the California Restaurant Association named The Firehouse wine list best for Californian wines in the state for restaurants with less than 10 locations. The Firehouse has also earned the coveted Best of Award of Excellence from *Wine Spectator* for the 8th consecutive year in 2009, and was voted Best of the Best (Money No Object), Best Wine List, Best Service, Best Special Occasion, Most Romantic and Best Outdoor Dining among other awards by the Subscribers of *Sacramento Magazine* in 2008 and 2009.
